APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

22.053 Cllr Beaven's apology for a late arrival was noted and approved

DECLARATIONS OF PECUNIARY INTEREST

22.054 Cllr McRae and Cllr King declared an interest in matters relating to the T&M Greg Trust in their capacity as Trustees of the T&M Greg Trust

MINUTES OF MEETING

22.055 The minutes of the WPC meeting held on 18 May 2022 were proposed by Cllr Partridge and seconded by Cllr King and approved by Parish Cllrs present as a correct record **UNAUTHORISED DEVELOPMENT ON CHERRY GREEN LANE (CGL) UPDATE**

22.056 Cllr Huggins recognised the lengthy delay in any decision from Planning. The applicants have responded to Highways recommendations for refusal by submitting revised plans including tree survey, highways drawings detailing tracking and splay visibility analysis and a traffic survey (resulting in a re-consultation of 3/21/2509/FUL). Highways has yet to produce its statement on the re-consultation and will follow a similar deadline and may review other feedback before submitting a new response. The officer will begin to draft recommendations as the 18 August deadline for comments has passed. If this application is recommended for approval it will go to Development Management Committee (DMC), the Agenda for the DMC will include officer recommendations and is a policy-based decision. Recently a Gypsy and Traveller (G&T) Needs Assessment for East Herts Council (EHC) has been carried out and concluded that there are not enough available pitches. There are sites in North Ware and Gilston which may increase in size. DMC date is not confirmed but may be 5 October although cancellation of 7 September DMC meeting may impact the expected date. Highway and arboricultural issues could be key factors in this application. In the event of refusal either directly from the planning officer or after DMC, EHC will then consider the breach of the injunction.

REPRESENTATION AT PLANNING COMMITTEE

22.057 In researching an individual to represent the village at DMC Cllr McRae has approached two Westmill residents with legal backgrounds. The speaker will have 3 minutes to state the case covering East Herts District Plan, policy, environmental impact and site history. Cllr Downes stated that the speaker be articulate and engaging. Cllrs McRae, Pickup and King agreed that a suitable Westmill resident known to them should be approached and Cllrs Downes, Partridge and Beaven agreed in principle and would like an opportunity to meet with the resident to seek agreement.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

22.058 **Q:** Does Cllr Huggins know what the planning officer decision on the G&T site in Westmill will be? **A:** Cllr Huggins explained that whilst he does engage in discussion with the planning team and knows the features of the case and policy, he cannot supply information on a final decision. This will be provided by the planning officer. **Q:** Should development be continuing whilst the injunction is in place? **A:** Cllr Huggins confirmed that there should be no development on the site and if there is, should be reported here:

22.061 Review of budget, only electricity is in excess of current budget due to disconnection of supply. 2023/4 budget proposal for next meeting

EAST HERTS WARD BOUNDARY CHANGES

New wards are effective at May 2023 local elections with Westmill, the Mundens, Ardeley, Sacombe and Bengeo Rural to form a single member ward with new representation

CHRISTMAS TREE AND LIGHTS

22.063 Cllrs Beaven and Partridge to attach lights to car battery and tree will be in place for 2 December lighting event

PLANNING

22.064 Cllr Huggins confirmed that the planning application has been received for Buntingford West (350 new homes) 3/22/1551/FUL. If approved, building construction will complete before roundabout construction so stress on the A10 will be increased. Doctor surgery may relocate to Nevitts site. Other planning details attached as an appendix to these minutes **HCC HIGHWAYS**

22.065 Highways has erected barriers and cleared debris around damaged bridge on north exit from village. Cllr Downes disappointed that repairs to the top of Station Hill have not been addressed

RISK ASSESSMENT

22.066 Parking damaging the village green was discussed and Cllr McRae to investigate additional posts with Cllrs Beaven, Partridge and Pickup to secure loose posts. Cllr Downes has a contact at EHC who will confirm if a request has been received to prune the large lime tree. If nothing received Cllr Downes will contact a different arboriculturalist. Cllr Partridge received a noticeboard quote for £1600 and will research means to fund this.

POLICE REPORT/NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH

22.067 Apologies from PCSO Karen Broad, unable to attend today due to operational constraints. Neighbourhood Watch representative Dennis Downes reported damaged bridge at north exit of Westmill to the Police. One theft of a catalytic convertor from a vehicle parked adjacent to the Children's playground. Incidents of dogs barking and running onto the public highway on CGL have been reported to Police.

GREG TRUST (GT)

22.068 Cllr McRae updated all present, the Village Hall floor has been sanded, retreated and polished. Structural engineer has been appointed to survey with further inspection and recommendations to come for roof repairs in summer 2023. Planning application submitted to improve living space layout of 4 Pilgrims Close. Tree survey in Twitchell identified 8 dead trees for removal mid-September. Report awaited from annual inspection of playground. Next meeting 26 September

CLERK/RFO REPORT

22.069 Small Authority Audit Appointments (SAAA) is appointing 2023-26 auditor and WPC will continue under this arrangement. Clerk to submit VAT return. Affinity Water is asking users to sign up to saveourstreams.co.uk

MATTERS ARISING

22.070 Cllr King gave a summary of the 'Levelling Up' Zoom meeting she attended with Cllr Beaven which focussed on the role of the PC in planning and regeneration via a Prosperity Fund with lots of new initiatives expected including waste aiming for 85% recycling (currently 46%). Cllr Downes suggested resident engagement to promote interest in the May 2023 PC elections, by promoting on 2 December tree lighting, household leafleting, website and social media? Cllr McRae is already actively promoting the roles in conversation with residents and other councillors are encouraged to do the same
